■ Ensemble Competition Application Guidelines

Repertoire : Piece(s) of up to 10 minutes in length, including the time between pieces. The ensemble will be disqualified from the competition if the total performance time exceeds 10 minutes. There is no limit on the number of pieces performed within the 10 minute time limit.

Ensembles must consist of guitars only, one performer per part. Electric amplification is not allowed. Multiple entries from the same person are not allowed.

Application Fee : Duo:8,000 yen/person (Ensemble Association Member:7,000 yen/person) Trio:7,000 yen/person
(Member:6,000 yen/person) Quartet and more:6,000 yen/person (Member:5,000 yen/person)

Application : Please mail the application form and the sheet music for the piece(s) to the Japan Guitar Ensemble Association by March 31, 2017 (valid if postmarked by March 31.) Please pay the application fee via bank transfer by the deadline. Participants are responsible for any additional transfer fees. ■Please write the ensemble name and “Application Fee for Ensemble Competition” in the memo upon making the bank transfer.

■No refund will be issued after the application fee is paid.

■ Ensemble Festival Application Guidelines

Repertoire : Piece(s) of up to 6 minutes in length. There is no limit on the number of pieces performed within the 6 minute time limit. One performer per part. (Guitar ensembles including different instruments are allowed, however, piano and electric instruments are not allowed.)

Application Fee :Duo:5,000 yen/person (Ensemble Association Member:4,500 yen/person) Trio:4,000 yen/person
(Member:3,500 yen/person) Quartet and more:3,000yen/person (Member:2,500 yen/person)

Please pay an extra 3,000 yen/minute (by group) if the length of the performance exceeds 6 minutes.

Application : Deadline and payment method are the same as the competition. Scores are not required.

■No refund will be issued after the application fee is paid.
